George and Theresa Adams Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established to provide financial assistance to area youth who have spent time in the foster care system who wish to pursue higher education and the many opportunities it affords for a successful, productive life.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Must be majoring in Education.
- GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Preference may be shown to students who have been involved in extra-curricular activities within the school and/or community.
- Preference may be shown to students who are employed.

Al & Patti Bahe Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established in memory of Al and Patti Bahe for their contributions to the Fremont area.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Participation on more than one Fremont High athletic teams.
- Preference may be given to students who demonstrate financial need and have been involved in extracurricular activities.

Arlington Education Foundation Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the Arlington Education Foundation. The recipient must be a current year graduating senior of Arlington High School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Arlington High School.
- GPA that ranks in the upper one-half of high school class.
- Preference may be shown for students demonstrating financial need.

Dr. Brian L. Anderson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship shall provide financial assistance to area young people who plan to pursue a major in Music and/or Music Education, and to celebrate the life of Dr. Brian L. Anderson, Fremont High School Director of Bands and Orchestra for 28 years.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from a high school in Dodge, Washington, or Burt counties.
- GPA of 2.5 or better
- Must be majoring in music.
- Preference may be shown for students demonstrating financial need.

Mike Baker Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Mike Baker, who passed away in 2010 in a car accident in Washington County.

Requirements:

- Current or previous year graduate of a high school in Dodge County or DC West High School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university with a major in Agriculture, Natural Resources or related field.
- GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Participation in outdoor recreation or related activities.

Jason Bechtel Memorial Welding Academy Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Jason Bechtel, who graduated in 2017 from Fremont Senior High School with Industrial Tech honors, and to provide scholarship support to eligible students interested in attending the Fremont High School/Metropolitan Community College Welding Academy.

Requirements:

- Applicant shall be a senior student at Fremont High School
- Applicant shall be a participant in the FHS/MCC Welding Academy
- Special consideration may be shown to active members of the FHS SkillsUSA program, and students demonstrating financial need.

Cedar Bluffs Alumni Association Scholarship

This fund was established to provide scholarships for higher education for graduating seniors attending Cedar Bluffs High School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Cedar Bluffs High School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Preference may be given to students involved in extracurricular activities and/or in the community.

Jamie Charleston Scholarship

A memorial scholarship which is awarded to one male and one female Fremont High School or Archbishop Bergan High School senior based on participation in tennis.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Member of the Fremont High School Tennis Team.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.

Dr. Darleen Ritter and Skip Anderson Class of 1962 Scholarship

This endowed scholarship fund was founded by alumni of Fremont High School Class of 1962 to provide scholarships to graduating Fremont High school seniors.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- GPA between 2.0 and 3.5
- Preference may be shown to students who demonstrate financial need and have been involved in extracurricular activities.

Francis George Conrad Scholarship

A memorial scholarship established by the Conrad family for students in Dodge, Saunders or Douglas Counties that plan to study agriculture.

Requirements:

- Current year senior or a previous graduate from a high school in Fremont/Dodge County or Saunders, Butler, Douglas or Cuming County.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university majoring in agricultural science or related studies.
- Preference may be given students who have participated in 4-H.

Grace Cunningham, First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) Scholarship

This fund was established to provide scholarship support to graduating seniors of Fremont area high schools, who have been active members of First Christian Church in Fremont and who are pursuing secondary education at a two- or four-year college, university, technical or trade school.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating student from a Fremont area high school.
- May attend any two- or four-year college, university, technical or trade school.
- Must demonstrate active participation in church.
- Must be in good academic standing.

Dodge County Humane Society Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established for students who are attending veterinary school or majoring in Animal Science.

Requirements:

- Current year or previous year graduate of a high school in Dodge or Washington County with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Plan to major in Veterinary or Animal Science.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Involvement in extracurricular activities and in the community.

Daniel Family Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established to provide scholarship support to students pursuing a career in the arts, a course of study leading to a degree or certificate, or to achieve a skill level at an arts school.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior or previous year graduates from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan High School
- Planning to pursue and area of study in the arts: theatre, music, dance, literary or visual arts.
- Planning to attend any accredited college, university or school of the arts. The educational organization's status can be described in section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- Provide evidence of financial need.
- Taken art courses.
- Preference may be shown to students involved in extracurricular activities.

James Ebers Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the Ebers family, with part of the scholarship funds raised through the Fremont Rotary Club.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- Exemplify the spirit of giving.
- GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- Demonstrate exceptional service to school and community.

Elvera Eckdahl Scholarship

This scholarship was established through a bequest by Elvera Eckdahl.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to major in Elementary Education.

Kenny Erickson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the family of Kenny Erickson. This fund honors Kenny's life by providing scholarships to graduating seniors from Arlington High School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Arlington High School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two-year college.
- Involved in extracurricular activities.
- Provide evidence of financial need.
- Preference given to agriculture or wildlife studies.

American Legion Auxiliary Unit 20 Scholarship

This scholarship was established to provide scholarship support to graduating seniors of Fremont High School and Archbishop Bergan High School who are pursuing secondary education at a two-year community college, vocational or trade school.

Requirements:

- Current year graduate from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- GPA within a 2.0 and 3.5.
- Planning to attend a two-year community college, vocational or trade school.
- Participated in community service.

First State Bank & Trust Company Hometown Support Scholarship

This scholarship was established to help those outstanding and talented students who plan to attend a post-secondary vocational, trade or technical school, and, eventually, to enhance the supply of skilled individuals to the Fremont area workforce.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year graduating student from Fremont High School or Archbishop Bergan High School
- Must be planning to attend a 2-year technical, trade or vocational college in Nebraska.

Larry and Mary Flamme Family Scholarship

A scholarship established by the Flamme family to support students going into the medical field.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior residing in Dodge County.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Involved in extracurricular activities.
- Planning to be a medical field major.

Ruth Frederiksen Scholarship Fund

This fund was established by the Will of Ruth I. Frederiksen and is awarded to area students for the study of dietetics or nutrition.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from a high school in Dodge County.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- Planning to major Dietetics or Nutrition
- Preference may be shown for students demonstrating financial need.

Fremont Area Art Association Hazel Keene Memorial Scholarship

Established by the Fremont Area Art Association and awarded to area students who plan to enroll in art school or as art majors.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year high school graduate.
- Must be planning to pursue a career in an Art-related field.
- Must provide a review of art-related activities.
- Planning to attend a two-or four-year college or university.
- Must be a well-rounded individual, academic success, and evidence of participation in extracurricular activities.
- Must be currently employed or have been employed in the past 4 years.

Fremont Area Association of Retired School Personnel Education Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established to provide financial assistance to high school seniors within the FACP's grant-making area who wish to pursue higher education and a career in education.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year graduating student from the following high schools: Archbishop Bergan Catholic, Arlington, Cedar Bluffs, Fremont High, Logan View NBC or Scribner-Snyder.
- Must plan to pursue a career in education.
- Must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

Fremont Area Association of Retired School Personnel Trade Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established to provide financial assistance to high school seniors within the FACP's grant-making area who wish to pursue higher education and a career in education.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year graduating student from one of the following high schools: Archbishop Bergan Catholic, Arlington, Cedar Bluffs, Fremont High, Logan View NBC or Scribner-Snyder.
- Must plan to pursue a career in a trade.
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Must be planning to attend a community college or trade/vocational school.

Fremont Business & Professional Women's Scholarship

A fund established to provide for scholarships for female high school graduates and female students continuing their education.

Requirements:

- Current or previous year graduating female senior from a high school in Dodge County.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Involved in extracurricular activities and in the community.
- Preference may be shown for students demonstrating financial need.

Fremont Credit Professionals Scholarship

This scholarship fund provides financial assistance to area high school seniors who wish to pursue higher education and a career in business.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating student from a Fremont area high school.
- Preference may be shown for students demonstrating financial need.

Fremont Kiwanis Club Scholarship

This fund was established by the Fremont Kiwanis Club for students attending a technical/vocational college or Midland University.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a two-year, vocational or technical college or Midland University.

Fremont High School Alumni Student Aid

A fund established by alumni of Fremont High School to provide college scholarships for students in need of financial assistance who are graduating or have graduated from Fremont High School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior or a previous graduate from Fremont High or the Fremont Learning Center.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Provide strong evidence of financial need.

Fremont Noon Kiwanis Harold Anderson Scholarship

This fund was established in honor of Harold Anderson and is awarded to Fremont students who plan to attend trade or vocational schools.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a two-year, vocational or technical college.

Fremont PTA/PTSA Scholarship

This scholarship fund is sponsored by the Fremont Citywide Parent Teachers Association for graduates of Fremont High School planning to major in Education.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- Planning to pursue a degree and career in Education.

Kristine Gale Leadership Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established by the Foundation's Board of Directors to honor Kristine Gale, a past executive director of the Fremont Area Community Foundation.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from a high school in Dodge County.
- Planning to attend a two or four-year college or university.
- GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Demonstrate leadership and entrepreneurial skills in a community organization, youth organization, place of employment or created a new program or project in the community.

Bruce Gocken Business Scholarship

A scholarship fund established in memory of Bruce Gocken for students planning to major in business or who have plans to operate a business.

Requirements:

- Current year or previous year graduate of a high school in Dodge, Saunders, or Washington County.
- Currently employed.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Planning to major in business, or any other field of study with plans to operate a business.
- Preference may be shown to students involved in extracurricular activities and/or in the community.
- Preference may be shown to students demonstrating financial need.

Trey Hansen Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Trey Hansen and provides a scholarship to a Fremont Senior High School current year graduating senior.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Planning to attend a non-profit college or university, or a community college.
- Demonstrate service to school and community.
- GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Participated in multiple extracurricular activities including sports and vocal music.

Matthew Hartmann Memorial Scholarship

This memorial scholarship fund was established in memory of Matthew Hartmann. It is awarded to a graduating senior from Fremont High School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Involvement in extracurricular activities and in the community.
- Participation in one of the following activities for at least two years: Cross Country, Band, or Soccer.

Sam Heineman Business Student of the Year Scholarship

This fund will provide a scholarship for the Fremont High School's Business Student of the Year.

Requirements:

- This student will have been named previously as the Business Student of the Month
- Taken 7+ business classes while maintaining a minimum 3.5 GPA in those classes

Haines Hill Memorial Scholarship

A memorial scholarship established by Taylor and Martin, Inc., and many friends of Haines Hill, former owner of Taylor and Martin. It is awarded to a Fremont student who will major in a business-related field of study.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- Planning to major in business.

Keith Hindmarsh Scholarship

This fund was established by the family of Keith Hindmarsh and is awarded to Arlington High School graduates planning to pursue an agricultural related degree.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior of Arlington High School.
- Planning to major in an agricultural related major.
- Leadership in the school or community.
- Taken business or agribusiness courses.

Mildred Hindmarsh Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to a current year graduating student at a high school in Arlington, Fremont or North Bend who is planning to major in Elementary Education.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating student attending high school in Fremont, Arlington, or North Bend.
- Planning to major in Elementary Education.
- GPA that ranks in the top 33% of my class.
- Preference may be given to students who have participated in the Future Teachers Club or who have volunteered with the elderly.

Don and Jan Hinds Educational Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Don and Jan Hinds for students who are planning to major in Education.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- Planning to major in Education.

Hiram Lodge #52 Masonic Scholarship

This fund will carry the Hiram Lodge #52 tradition of providing financial assistance to graduating seniors of Arlington High School.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year graduating student at Arlington High School.
- Must be attending two or four year-college/university, technical or trade school.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or lower.

Jim A. Hoshor Scholarship

This scholarship was established to provide scholarship support to graduating seniors of Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan High School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High, Archbishop Bergan Catholic, Arlington, or Cedar Bluffs.
- Planning to attend Doane College and participate in football, baseball, or softball.
- GPA of 2.0 or higher.

Allyssa, Sheldon, Mariah Johnson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established by the memorial gifts of many donors and is awarded to a Fremont High School graduate.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Planning to pursue a degree serving children under the age of 17 in any field of study.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.

Emmett & Mae Johnson Scholarship

This fund was established by Lester A. and Maxine Walker in honor of Mrs. Walker's parents.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior of Tekamah-Herman High School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.

Rodney & Amy Mueller Johnson Memorial Scholarship

A memorial scholarship fund was established by the gifts of many donors. One scholarship is awarded to a Fremont High School graduate and one to a Logan View High School graduate.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont High School or Logan View High School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Preference may be shown to students demonstrating financial need.

Kim Koski Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is for a Fremont High School senior pursuing higher education dealing with children.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont High School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college/university or community college.
- Planning a degree in serving children under the age of 17 in any field of study.

H.M."Micky" Krupinsky Scholarship

This scholarship was sponsored by the Fremont Golf Club as a memorial to H. M. "Micky" Krupinsky and is awarded to students interested in golf.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Involvement in extracurricular activities.
- Participation in golf throughout high school.

Alexander N. Lamme Academic-Athletic Scholarship

This memorial scholarship fund was established in memory of Alex Lamme. The award benefits a boy or girl Fremont High School Track and Field Team Member or Fremont High School Basketball Team Member.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating student from Fremont High School.
- May attend any college or university, a technical or trade school or any post-high school education.
- Must be a boy or girl who is an active member of the Fremont High Track and Field Team, Cross Country, or Fremont High School Basketball Team.

Janet Ludwig Scholarship

This scholarship fund provides support for current year graduating seniors from Arlington High School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Arlington High School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.

LaVern F. Lueschen Scholarship

A memorial scholarship awarded to a Fremont student majoring in science, pre-medical or pre-dental studies.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Planning to major in science, pre-medical, or pre-dental studies.
- Participation in trapshooting and/or sports.
- Provide evidence of financial need.

Jerome S. Main Agriculture Scholarship

This scholarship, established in memory of Jerome S. Main, provides financial assistance to a student planning to pursue a career in agriculture.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year graduating student pursuing a career in agriculture.
- Must be planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- Must have at least a 2.5 GPA
- Must have participated in ag-related extra-curricular activities.
- Preference for those with financial need

Ray Mitchell Golf Scholarship

This scholarship, established in memory of Ray Mitchell, provides financial assistance to a student with prior and active golf activity.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year graduating student from a high school located in Dodge County
- Must be planning to attend any two-or four-year college, technical or trade school.
- Must be able to demonstrate prior and active participation in golf activities such as: a high school team, through competitive golf, league play, and/or recreational play.

Jake Monke Achievement Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established to celebrate the life of Jake Monke and help others achieve their goals and dreams. It will provide financial assistance to graduating seniors from Arlington High School who wish to pursue higher education.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont High School, Archbishop Bergan, Cedar Bluffs, Arlington High School, Logan View or North Bend Central High School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Pat Murphy Track and Field Scholarship

This scholarship, established in honor of Pat Murphy, provides a scholarship for Fremont Senior High Track and Field Team members.

Requirements:

- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Member of the Fremont High School Track and Field Team.
- Provide evidence of financial need.

E.V. "Vic" and Lois Nielsen Fremont Noon Optimists Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established by the Nielsen family and the Fremont Noon Optimist Club as a memorial to E.V. "Vic" and Lois Nielsen, long-time supporters of the Fremont area.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Planning to pursue a degree in a health care related field.
- Provide evidence of financial need.

Nitz Family Scholarship

The scholarship fund is to honor the memory of Jack Raymond Nitz and shall provide financial assistance to Cedar Bluffs high school graduates who pursue a post-secondary education at a 2-year college, technical or trade school. This scholarship will be used for tuition, books or fees.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Cedar Bluffs Senior High School
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Planning to attend a trade/technical school or a two-year college.
- Involved in at least one extra-curricular activity for at least two years including his/her senior year.

Loren Nothwehr Scholarship

This scholarship was established to honor Loren Nothwehr for his years of volunteer service to Fremont organizations.

Requirements:

- Planning to major in Sociology or Human Services, or such other major as relates to the care and support of poor, homeless, abused or neglected persons.
- Current year or graduating senior or previous year graduate from a high school in Dodge County with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Involved in extracurricular activities and in the community.

James L. Paulin Fremont Kiwanis Club Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the late Jim Paulin, a long-time member of the Fremont Kiwanis Club.

Requirements:

- Planning to attend Midland University.
- Current year graduating senior or previous year graduate from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Involved in Key Club or Circle K.

Valerie Post Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established to memorialize the life of Valerie Post Sullivan and celebrate her lifelong passion for the performing arts.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont High School.
- Demonstrate involvement in performing arts and/or fine arts.
- Preference may be shown to students who have been involved in extra-curricular activities or those who demonstrate financial need.

Rhea Family Scholarship

This scholarship was established for students from the Dodge County area that have participated in extra-curricular activities.

Requirements:

- Current or previous year graduate of a high school in the Dodge County area (includes surrounding counties).
- Planning to attend a technical, two- or four year-college or university in Nebraska.
- GPA that ranks or ranked in the upper one-half of my high school class.
- Participation in extra-curricular activities.
- Preference may be shown to students pursuing a career in healthcare or agriculture.

Coach Melcher Scholarship

The scholarship was established in honor of Coach Heidi Melcher's long coaching and teaching career at Fremont Public Schools, and to provide scholarship support to graduating seniors who have participated in Girls Cross Country.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Must have participated on a Girls Cross Country Team for at least one year.

Rotary Club Youth Scholarship

This scholarship is for seniors of Fremont High School or Archbishop Bergan High School who exemplify the Rotary ideal of "Service above Self." Scholarship winners will be selected based upon exemplary citizenship and character expressed through community activity, personal and academic achievement, and "service above self." Top candidates will need to interview with the selection committee.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating student from Fremont High School or Archbishop Bergan High School.
- Must be planning to attend a two-or four-year college or university.
- Must have a 2.5 GPA or greater.
- Must be able to demonstrate extra-curricular activities and community service.

Sherlock Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was established in honor of the late Barbara L. Sherlock.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior or a previous year graduate from a high school in Dodge County.
- Planning to enroll in a degree program leading to licensure as a Registered Nurse, and/or a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree.
- Provide evidence of persistence and determination in achieving goals.

Anne Crofton Sidner Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship provides scholarships for current year graduating seniors from Fremont Senior High School who intend to pursue an education including some courses in liberal arts.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School who has attended all four years.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- GPA that ranks in the upper 10% of the graduating class.
- Pursue an education which includes courses in liberal arts.
- Participated in physical activities and/or sports.
- Held a leadership position and demonstrated integrity.
- Preference may be shown to students who have participated in extra-curricular activities.

Team Mates Mentoring Program Scholarship

A fund established to provide scholarships to students who have participated in the Team Mates Program at Fremont schools.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Active in the TeamMates of Fremont Program for a minimum of two years.
- Planning to pursue higher education at a 2-year or 4-year college or university, or vocational training programs such as CDL, CNA, or cosmetology school.

Robert L. Tookey Scholarship

A fund established by the estate of Robert Tookey to provide scholarships for students majoring in music with a focus in piano and/or organ.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior or previous year graduate from a high school in Dodge, Washington, Saunders and Cuming Counties or areas 20 miles west of Douglas County.
- Planning to pursue a major in music or music education, with emphasis in the area of piano and/or organ.
- Preference may be shown to students demonstrating financial need.

Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) – Post 854 Scholarship

To provide financial assistance to graduating seniors of Fremont High School and surrounding high schools of the Fremont area pursuing post-secondary education in the industrial trades or certified nursing assistant.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont High School, Archbishop Bergan, Arlington High School, Cedar Bluffs High School or Logan View High School.
- Majoring in a trade.
- Planning to attend a vocational/Technical school, two-year college/university, or community college.

Tyler Walling Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship, established in memory of Tyler Walling, provides a scholarship to a current year graduating senior from Fremont High School or Arlington High School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont High School or Arlington High School with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Involvement in extracurricular activities and in the community.
- Preference may be given to students who have developed leadership skills throughout my high school career (e.g., Eagle Scout, Student Council).

Jean M. Welstead Memorial Scholarship

This fund was established to provide financial assistance to area high school seniors who plan to pursue a career in an Art-related field.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year high school graduate.
- Must be planning to pursue a career in an Art-related field.
- Must provide a review of art-related activities.
- Planning to attend a two-or four-year college or university.
- Must be a well-rounded individual, academic success, and evidence of participation in extracurricular activities.
- Must be currently employed or have been employed in the past 4 years.

Marvin G. Welstead Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the Board of Directors to honor Marvin G. Welstead for his years of service as President of the Foundation.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- Planning to major in business.
- Provide evidence of financial need.
- GPA that ranks in the top 25% of class.

Mary Ellen Wieland Scholarship

This fund was established by the Will of Mary Ellen Wieland for graduates of Howard School who will major in Elementary Education.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School or Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.
- Planning to attend a four-year college or university.
- Attended Howard Elementary School for at least one year.
- GPA that ranks in the top 25% of class.
- Planning to major in Elementary Education.

Dave Williams Golf Scholarship

This scholarship provides support to graduating seniors or continuing education students who have graduated from a high school in Fremont, Arlington or Cedar Bluffs, Nebraska, who will attend a two- or four-year college, technical or trade school and have demonstrated an interest and ability in golf.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior or former graduate from a Fremont, Arlington or Cedar Bluffs high school.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two- or four-year college or university.
- Interest and ability in golf.
- Good scholastic record.
- GPA that ranks or ranked in the upper one-half of high school class.
- Preference may be shown to students demonstrating financial need.

Marty Williamson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is to provide financial assistance to an FHS student who plans to pursue a career in the construction trades.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior.
- Planning to attend a vocational/technical school, or a two-year college or community college.
- GPA is 2.5 or higher.
- Planning to major in a trade.
- Community Service

Robert Yanike Music Scholarship

This fund was established by the friends of Robert Yanike to support the advanced study of music for Fremont High School graduates.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating senior from Fremont Senior High School.
- Participation in choral music both inside and outside of school.

Arbor Vitae Eastern Star Scholarship

This scholarship was established to support graduating seniors of Fremont Senior High School who are pursuing secondary education at a four-year college or university, with preferences detailed on the attached Statement of Understanding.

Requirements:

- Current year graduate from Fremont Senior High School.
- Must attend any four-year college or university.
- Primary preference given to students that have been involved in DeMolay, Job's Daughters or Rainbow for Girls.
- Secondary preference given to students that have been active in school, church, and/or community.
- Demonstrates good citizenship and high moral character.

Arbor Vitae Eastern Star Shrine Bowl Scholarship

This scholarship was established to provide financial assistance to band students attending the annual Shrine Bowl event.

Requirements:

- Must be attending the annual Shriner Bowl
- Current year graduate from Fremont Senior High School.

Grand Passage Sportsmen Scholarship

This scholarship was established to support and encourage youth interest in outdoor sports and activities and provide financial assistance for high school graduating seniors pursuing secondary education.

Requirements:

- Must be a current year graduate from North Bend Central High School or Schuyler Central High School.
- May attend any two- or four-year college, university, vocational or trade school.
- Preference given to students that demonstrate outdoor activity involvement. (e.g., fishing, hunting, trapshooting)
- Preference given to students that pursue a vocation in an outdoor area of study.

Richard A and Joyce E Klebe Scholarship

This scholarship was established to provide support to graduating seniors who have graduated from Fremont Senior High School and Archbishop Bergan Catholic School.

Requirements:

- Current year graduating student from Fremont Senior High School or Bergan High School
- May attend any non-profit college, university, community college, or trade school.
- GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Evidence of participation in multiple extracurricular activities including sports and fine arts.
- Demonstration of service to school and community.
- Technological studies to be considered.
